PROFESSIONAL BIOGRAPHY

Educational background

Tomás Entrezede holds an Integrated Master's Degree in Architecture from the **Faculty of Architecture at the University of Lisbon (FAUL)** in 2024, where he consistently excelled both academically and creatively. After completing the first cycle of studies with a GPA of 17.14 (out of 20), he went on to complete his final Master's thesis—*DOMUS IUSTITIAE, O Novo Equipamento Judicial de Sines*—with the highest possible grade: 20 out of 20. His academic excellence was recognized with two Merit Scholarships awarded by the University of Lisbon in 2021 and 2023. In addition, he was just accepted to enroll at the Doctoral Degree (3rd cycle of studies) at FAUL.

Career to date

Tomás' professional journey reflects a growing expertise in architectural design and urban rehabilitation, marked by diverse experiences across Portugal and Spain. Besides the studio practical work, Tomás also works in FAUL as an assistant Professor in the Class of Final Master's project of the 2nd year of the Master's in **FAUL**.

He began his career, while studying, at **HIGHPLAN / ARQUITECTOS**, in 2019, where he was involved in all phases of the architectural process—from preliminary studies and licensing projects to execution, budgeting, and site supervision. This role also introduced him to BIM-based design tools, especially ArchiCAD, and provided hands-on experience in project management and client relations.

Their international perspective was broadened through a 4-month internship at **Ruiz Barbarin Arquitectos** in Madrid, undertaken as part of the ERASMUS+ Graduate program. During this time, Entrezede focused primarily on large-scale urban rehabilitation projects, contributing to the redevelopment of significant commercial buildings in central Madrid.

Complementing these roles, Entrezede co-founded **DA ARQUITECTURA**, a creative platform built in collaboration with two university colleagues. The initiative supported architecture professionals by offering specialized services in 3D modeling, 3D printing, and image post-production.

Once returned from Spain, Tomás E. rejoined HIGHPLAN's team and he is now undertaking the legal internship to join the Portuguese Public Association of Architects.

Professional Experiences

Throughout his young career, Entrezede has combined architectural vision with technical precision across a range of projects and scales. Since his early years at HIGHPLAN he was involved in collaborating with construction partners, budgeting, and participation in public competitions, grounding him in the realities of architectural execution. The platform DA ARQUITECTURA allowed him to explore the intersection between technology and design, delivering high-quality visual outputs that enhanced client presentations and project communication while still enrolling in public and academic competitions.

The experience at Ruiz Barbarin Arquitectos, allowed him to develop technical and personal skills by working with foreign colleagues. These experiences, together with their strong academic foundation and creative initiatives, position Tomás as a dynamic young architect with a multidisciplinary approach and a commitment to both innovation, contextual sensitivity, sustainability and resilience in architecture.
